

# Important Safety Instructions

## 1. General Information

- Read these instructions carefully and keep them for future reference. Observe and follow all instructions.
- Not suitable for children under 6 years! The package may contain small parts that can be swallowed.
  - Risk of suffocation from plastic films and small parts. Keep films, bags, straps, etc., away from children to prevent suffocation.
  - Children can become entangled in cables. Store cables out of reach of children.
- Always inspect the product for damage before use. If damage is present, do not use the product.
  Repair, maintenance, or replacement is required if any kind of damage exists. For instance,
  if liquid or foreign objects have entered the device, the device has been exposed to rain or
  moisture, it no longer functions properly, or it has been dropped. Contact your retailer to have
  the device inspected.

#### 2. Storage

- Avoid placing liquids in locations exposed to direct sunlight, temperature fluctuations, or high humidity. Do not place liquids near heaters, heat lamps, or other devices that generate heat.
- Never operate electrical devices near water.
- If batteries (including battery packs or replaceable dry batteries) are used, do not expose them to direct sunlight, fire, or excessive heat.

#### 3. Maintenance

Never use aggressive cleaning agents.

- Prolonged exposure to high volume levels can cause various types of hearing damage.
   Use high volumes responsibly.
